

Methodology for applying KABU CLEAR COAT

SURFACE PREPERATIONS

To ensure the long-term structural integrity of your surface and prevent any future leakage issues, it is critical that the terrace surface is prepared with the correct slope and material specifications before the final waterproofing treatment and any vertical surface shall be prepared with crack filling and free from all dust particles.

Below are the detailed methodology and process.

Application Areas: At Concrete surfaces, Kota Stones, Matt Tiles, Paver Blocks, Cementitious Surfaces, Waterproof cementitious coatings etc.

No. of Coats advised: TOP Coat application = min 2 coats

Application: Apply with Roller / Brush / Sponge without mixing anything.

1. Clean the surface completely from dust or any other dirt.
2. Rub the surface with 180 to 220 grit sandpaper to make it smooth and rough in case of glossy finish surface.
3. Clean the surface with wet cloth completely to remove the dust created by rubbing the sandpaper.
4. Apply the 1st Coat and allow it to touch dry for minimum upto 15 mins @ 30 degree temperature and allow full dry for around 90 to 120 mins before applying the 2nd coat.
5. Apply the 2nd coat and allow it to full dry / hard dry for upto 2 to 3 hours @ 30 degree temperature and allow full dry for around 3 to 4 hours before using the surface.

Note:

In case if the application is done in humid area or with less of ventilation or air circulation then the drying time of each coat will be more.

What to Avoid:

1. Avoid direct application on the surface having cracks / deep tile joints / uneven / etc.
2. This product is a lamination coating for non-pores surfaces and also the surface shall be in level.
3. In case if you want to apply on tiles for waterproofing then first do grouting of all tile joints with KABU SHED / KABU BOND mixed with white cement and fill it to make the same level of tiles. After that apply the lamination Coating.
